The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topic that may be addressed in the proposed regulations NAC 62B, 63:

- Establishes factors for a juvenile court to consider before placing child at a child care facility or with an agency that provides child welfare services;
- Establishes required protocols for foster homes, child care facilities and emergency shelters, foster care agencies and agencies which provide child welfare services to ensure each child who is placed in out-of-home care is placed in a manner that is appropriate for the gender identity and expression of the child; and
- Establishes a procedure for children and if applicable parents or guardians to file a grievance concerning a foster home, foster care agency, an agency which provides child welfare services, an out-of-home placement, or a facility in which the child who is in the custody of an agency which provides child welfare services is placed, a division facility, a psychiatric hospital or any public or private institution or agency to which a child is committed by a court. Such procedure must include a process for resolving grievances by a natural party with remedies including but not limited those found in statute.
- Establishes requirements for foster caregivers and employees to receive approved training in working with lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and questioning children, initially and annually thereafter.
