The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topic that may be addressed in the proposed regulations related to **Title 5** of the Nevada Revised Statutes:

- Establishes factors for a juvenile court to consider before placing child at a local facility for the detention of children, a regional facility for the placement and rehabilitation of children, state facility for the detention of children or another public or private facility or agency; and
- Establishes required protocols for facilities housing juvenile justice youth to ensure each child who is committed or placed at a facility is placed in a manner that is appropriate for the gender identity and expression of the child.

The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topic that may be addressed in the proposed regulations related to **Title 39** of Nevada Revised Statutes:

- Establishes factors for a juvenile court to consider before placing child at a treatment facility or other division facility; and
- Establishes required protocols for children’s mental health facilities to ensure each child who is placed at a facility is placed in a manner that is appropriate for the gender identity and expression of the child.
