ABA Policy History

- CMS released guidance in 2014 on Autism Spectrum Disorder under state plan services.
- The most recent State Plan Amendment was approved by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services January 2019
- ABA services became effective in Nevada on January 1, 2016.

ABA Policy Overview

- Medicaid recipients aged 0-21
- The service is medically necessary (MSM Chapter 100)
- Diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Fetal Alcohol Spectrum
 Disorder (FASD) or other condition for which ABA is recognized as medically
 necessary.
- Diagnosis is submitted on a FA11-F noting the appropriate diagnostic tool https://www.medicaid.nv.gov/Downloads/provider/FA-11F.pdf

ABA Services

Focused Model

 Treatment directly provided to the individual for a limited number of specific behavioral targets.

Comprehensive Model

 Treatment provided to the individual for a multiple number of targets across domains of functioning including cognitive, communicative, social and emotional

Prior authorization

• Required for all services, except the assessment. The Assessment is allowed 1 time every 180 days.

Coverage

- Assessments
- Adaptive Behavior Treatment (Individual & Group)
- Adaptive Behavior Family Treatment without child present
- Adaptive Behavior Family Treatment with child present

Welcome to the State of Nevada Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) webpage. On July 7th, 2014, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) released guidance on approaches available under the federal Medicaid program for providing medically necessary diagnostic and treatment services to children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

The DHCFP covers ABA services rendered to Medicaid eligible individuals under age 21, including children with ASD, based on individual determinations of medical necessity.

Definitions

Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is a group of developmental disabilities that can cause significant social, communication and behavioral challenges. A diagnosis of ASD can include Autistic Disorder, Pervasive Developmental Disorder - Not Otherwise Specified (PDD-NOS), or Asperger's Disorder.

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) is the design, implementation, and evaluation of environmental alterations to produce socially significant improvement in human behavior, including the use of direct observation, measurement and functional analysis of the relations between environment and behavior.
