B. Location of child at the time of death or near fatality (city/county):

Las Vegas, Clark

C. A summary of the report of abuse or neglect and a factual description of the contents of the report:

Law enforcement and emergency medical personnel responded to a local residence on a 9-1-1 call relating to an unresponsive infant. The Infant was transported to a local hospital where he was later pronounced deceased.

D. The date of birth and gender of child:

5/15/2019, Male

E. The date that the child suffered the fatality or near fatality:

7/26/2019

F. The cause of the fatality or near fatality, if such information has been determined:

No maltreatment was found to be a factor in the fatality incident.

G. Whether the agency had any contact with the child or a member of the child's family or household before the fatality or near fatality and, if so...

- (1) The frequency of any contact or communication with the child or a member of the child's family or household before the fatality or near fatality and the date on which the last contact or communication occurred before the fatality or near fatality;

This limitation is required to preserve the confidentiality of all child abuse and neglect reports and records in order to protect the rights of the child and family as mandated by the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA), as amended (42 U.S.C. 5101 et seq.).

6/30/2004 – A report was received alleging abuse and neglect. Upon conclusion of a requisite investigation, the allegations were found substantiated.

5/17/2007 – A report was received alleging neglect. CCDFS responded to the reported address and upon appropriate inquiry, information was received that the family no longer resided at the address. CCDFS conducted diligent search efforts to locate the family, including accessing relevant human services databases. Due to unsuccessful attempts to make contact with the family and insufficient information available to support the allegations, the allegations were unsubstantiated and the case closed.

9/30/2007 – A report was received alleging abuse and neglect. Court action was initiated and relevant family members were determined to be in need of protection. The allegations were found substantiated. The family was placed under formal supervision and a case plan put in place. Appropriate referrals and services were provided to the family. During the course of the open case, a report was received on 5/14/2010 alleging abuse that was found substantiated. This report involved an adult caregiver who the children had been placed with. The children were removed from this placement as a result of the report. On 3/8/2011, the court terminated jurisdiction and wardship, with the children being released into the care of the appropriate parent. The case closed.

4/12/2016 – A report was received alleging neglect. CCDFS responded to the reported address and upon appropriate inquiry, information was received that the family no longer resided at the address. CCDFS conducted diligent search efforts to locate the family, including accessing relevant human services databases. Due to unsuccessful attempts to make contact with the family and insufficient information available to support the allegations, the allegations were unsubstantiated and the case closed.

7/16/2017 – A report was received alleging neglect. Upon conclusion of a requisite investigation, the allegation was found unsubstantiated. The family was provided with an appropriate brochure, as well as information regarding community resources.

9/15/2017 – A report was received alleging neglect. Upon conclusion of a requisite investigation, the allegations were found unsubstantiated.

7/6/2018 – A report was received alleging abuse. Upon conclusion of a requisite investigation, the allegations were found unsubstantiated. The family was provided with referrals based upon their needs, as well as information regarding community resources, and the case closed.

5/15/2019 – A report was received alleging abuse and neglect. Upon conclusion of a requisite investigation, the allegations were found unsubstantiated.

CCDFS has completed its investigation and family assessment. The investigation found no evidence to support the fatality was a result of maltreatment. No further CPS intervention nor referrals were deemed necessary and the case has been closed.
