Information for Release:

- A. Date of the notification to the child welfare agency of the death of a child:
DCFS was notified of the near fatality on 1-19-2018. Child passed away on 1/25/2018.
- B. Location of child at the time of death or near fatality (city/county):
Pahrump, Nye County
- C. A summary of the report of abuse or neglect and a factual description of the contents of the report:
DCFS on call worker was notified at 3:54 AM that a child was enroute to a local hospital. Child was found in crib unresponsive. CPR was started and 911 was called. Child was then life flighted to a different hospital and listed in critical condition. Child passed away.
- D. The date of birth and gender of child:
8-24-2017 - Male
- E. The date that the child suffered the fatality or near fatality:
Near fatality - 1-19-2018
Fatality - 1-25-2018
- F. The cause of the fatality or near fatality, if such information has been determined:
Cause of the near/ fatality has not yet been determined. Awaiting reports/updates from local hospital.

G. Whether the agency had any contact with the child or a member of the child's family or household before the fatality or near fatality and, if so:

- (1) The frequency of any contact or communication with the child or a member of the child's family or household before the fatality or near fatality and the date on which the last contact or communication occurred before the fatality or near fatality;

8-24-2017 - A report was received alleging substance exposed infant (34A). Upon conclusion of the assessment, the allegations were found substantiated. DCFS has been providing services to family members for the past five months. This includes monthly face to face contacts, referrals for resources and services.

The case continues to be open for services.

H. Whether the agency which provides child welfare services, in response to the fatality or near fatality:
