- CIP secured a contract with the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges (NCJFCJ) to provide assistance with the annual CIC Summit and offer virtual training opportunities throughout the year.
- CIP secured a contract with Data Savvy Consulting to provide data collection, analysis, and evaluation support services to CIP, and agreed to look into individualized projects, based on the needs of each Judicial District.
- With assistance from DCFS and our Chief Deputy D.A.'s, CIP developed online training that addresses KinGAP, Reasonable Efforts, and Concurrent Planning for court stakeholders. This training is available on the Supreme Court website and is being addressed during the monthly CIC's.
- CIP is collaborating with the Criminal Justice Act (CJA) Task Force to assist
 with the planning and implementation of activities related to the requirements
 of the Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA).
- CIP is working with the Educational Advisory Board to identify areas where we may be able to provide assistance.
- CIP is working with Judy Tudor and the Casey Foundation to identify training opportunities for court stakeholders.
- CIP assisted the new GAL programs with developing volunteer training.
- CIP is collaborating with Drew Christensen, appointed administrator in Clark County to assist with mandatory training for track attorneys.
- CIP continues to participate in addressing Nevada's Program Improvement Plan goals, including those under Team 3 pertaining to the courts.
- CIP continues to implement the General Fund supported Juvenile Dependency Mediation Program (JDMP).
- CIP is actively participating in meetings of the DCFS CORE PIP Team, the Children's Commission, the Nevada Diligent Recruitment and Adoption Call to Action, and the Children's Bureau's NV-CFSR regularly scheduled meetings.
