- Begin their post high school education within 12 months of being awarded the scholarship
- Have a 2.0 GPA
- Plan on attending school full time

# **HOW TO APPLY**

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before April 15<sup>th</sup>
