### ***Pre-Award Obligations***

The following Pre-Award Obligations summarize the various training requirements to be completed before VOCA Funding Decisions & Awards are announced. Provided schedule of dates are proposed as of the release of Course 1: Designing for Impact – Nevada Strategic Investment System for VOCA and subject to change at any time pursuant to the direction of the Nevada Victims of Crime Program. Any changes to this proposed schedule will be communicated by email through the VOCA SIS Training Platform.

- Complete Course 1: Designing for Impact – Nevada Strategic Investment System for VOCA (VOCA 101)
  - Course link will be provided in the VOCA RFA as well as posted online.
  - Course completion due prior to RFA submission as part of the RFA process.
- Complete Course 2: Proposals and Scopes – Nevada Strategic Investment System for VOCA (Request for Applications and Scopes of Work 101)
  - Course invitation will be sent to all “VOCA Eligible Participants” within 15-days of RFA Submission deadline.
  - Course completion due within 45-days of course invitation.
- Complete additional mandatory online training courses in sequential order within 6 months following VOCA funding award.
  - Staying the Course – Nevada Strategic Investment System for VOCA (Quality and Compliance)
  - 21<sup>st</sup> Century Cultural Competency – Nevada Strategic Investment System for VOCA (Cultural Competency)
  - The Power of Information – Nevada Strategic Investment System for VOCA (Data and Evaluation)
