Posted: May 17, 2019 ******************************** Ouestion 1: Does the IVB program need to be (evidence-based) promising, supported or wellsupported to qualify for IVB funding? Answer 1: For SFY20, funding is not contingent on evidence-based programs. GMU is trying to determine which programs are evidence-based for training purposes and to determine technical assistance needs of agencies. ************************************* If an applicant intends to or could provide services in both urban and rural areas of the Ouestion 2: State, should they submit multiple applications—one for each of the major geographic areas they are proposing to serve? Answer 2: One application is enough however a separate scope of work and budget narrative is necessary for each service area. Just make sure the narrative identifies the services that will be provided in each service area. **************** Question 3: Is one organization able to apply for funding in multiple areas, for different programs within our organization, i.e. for Family Preservation and for Adoption Support services? Answer 3: Yes, an organization may apply for funding in multiple areas or different programs. One application is sufficient however a separate scope of work and budget narrative is necessary for each service area or program. ***************** Ouestion 4: Historically this has been a 3-year award; is this RFP only for 1 year, 7/1/19 - 6/30/20? Answer 4: Yes, this RFA is only for 1 year of funding. *******************************

Question 5: What is the exact funding period. On pages 2 and 7 of the RFA it is indicated for 1 year, 7/1/19-6/30/20; however, in the Application Section A, sub-section J Funding Request", it states: "List funding requested for the Two-year project award period". Should I be requesting funds for 1 or 2 years?

Answer 5: This was an oversight by GMU, the RFA is for 1 year of funding, July 1,2019 - June 30, 2020.

Question 6: I have a question regarding the application for the Title IV-B, Subpart 2 grant for PSSF. The instructions state that the application narrative should not exceed 15 pages in length. Does this include Sections A, B, and C? Or is it only section B – Narrative that must be 15 pages or less?

Answer 6: Only Section B-Narrative should not exceed 15 pages in length.
