

## Recidivism Report

Noble broadly defines recidivism as a subsequent referral after the initiation of services on an existing referral. This basic definition serves as the basis for the recidivism report.

Further refinement is available, however, by allowing the definition to be narrowed by the inclusion of only particular types of re-offenses.

This report counts recidivism as felony and misdemeanor re-offenses that occur any time subsequent to the first charge found within the interval range.

Note: This report considers all initial charges, with a qualifying disposition that is not pending.

PERCENT OF POPULATION THAT HAS RECIDIVATED

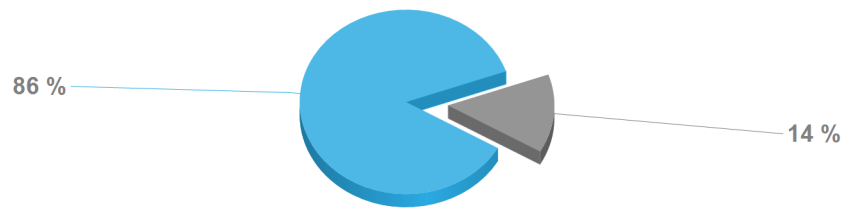

COUNT OF POPULATION GROUPED BY RISK LEVEL

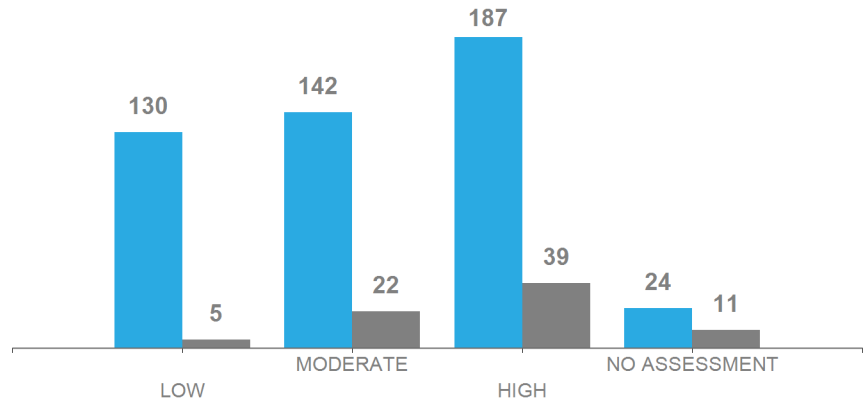
