

## **2016-2018 RFP Webinar questions**

**1. Where do we start our page numbers?**

Start your page number on the coversheet of the Application Kit. You must also make sure all documents are numbered including the Assurances and Certificates.

**2. Is there a base or a limit to the amount of funds we get?**

For VOCA and FVPSA the answer is no. For ML the amount that is awarded is based on population.

**3. One board member of our agency needs to be a victim of crime. True or False?**

True. To be eligible for a grant from the account for aid for victims of domestic violence, an applicant must:

Be governed by a board of trustees, which reflects the racial, ethnic, economic and social composition of the county to be served and includes at least one trustee who has been a victim of domestic violence

**4. Registering our agency with the State of Nevada Secretary of State and State of Nevada Controllers Office is for all agencies or new agencies?**

Any agency not currently registered with a vendor number will need to register if you are applying for any of the grants.

**5. Will the awards be issued for the three years or annually?**

Funds are awarded on a SFY basis and are dependent upon availability of funding, compliance with grant requests and scopes of work (SOW). The SFY starts on July 1<sup>st</sup> and ends on July 30<sup>th</sup> of each year. Unused funds from one year will not be automatically carried forward (re-awarded) to the next year. Current grantees are not guaranteed funding in SFY 16-18 and applicants who receive awards through this RFP are not guaranteed future funding.
