Review and Preliminary Roundtable Outcomes

In March of 2010, Permanency staff identified approximately 1,393 youth who had been in foster care for longer than 18 months. Permanency staff reviewed these cases and identified that approximately 305 of these youth could achieve permanency and could be closed by June 2010. To date, 281 of those cases have been closed. The remaining 1,088 could not achieve permanency by June 2010.

The Permanency Roundtable process facilitated a focus on permanency for youth who have been in care for longer periods of time. Children in care longer than 18 months are identified through length of stay reports and roundtable meetings are convened. Appendix D includes examples of the Excel tracking sheets (with last names removed) that are presently used to monitor the child level outcomes. The following outcomes have been currently achieved for the 67 cases that were reviewed: 5 cases reunified (7%) 8 cases emancipated (12%) and 2 (3%) were placed in a less restrictive settings.


Clark County DFS Plan to Expedite Permanency

- 1) Partner with Training Team to incorporate Permanency Values Training into New worker Core once train the trainers is received from Casey Family Programs.
- 2) Partner with Training Team to offer Permanency Value Training to internal and external stakeholders as recommended by the Permanency Roundtable Focus Groups.
- 3) Attend Casey Family Program Train the Trainers when offered.
- Receive technical assistance from Casey regard Permanency Meetings.
- 5) Request technical assistance for case mining from Casey Family Programs and utilize staff from the recruitment grant to facilitate case mining whenever recommended by the Permanency Roundtable.
- 6) Gather a panel of relative care providers to speak with Judges and Hearing Masters regarding their desire for guardianship as opposed to adoption in addition to providing training perhaps through Court Improvement Project on why legal guardianship is a permanent option.

- 7) Utilize staff that was core Permanency Roundtable participants in December and January to create 3 Permanency Roundtable Team to serve the regional areas that will initially meet twice a month.
- 8) Prioritize staffing the remaining 110 cases that were identified as being poor or uncertain over the next 6 months.
- 9) Open up the Permanency Roundtable for the following cases:
 - a. At 10 months from removal there has not been a Reunification Child and Family Team, TPR was not been filed or TPR is filed but there is no identified adoptive resource, or guardianship has not been referred.
 - b. TPR has been granted but there is no adoptive resource.
 - c. Prior to recommending the permanency goal of OPPLA.
 - d. When the concurrent planning guide indicates that the prognosis for reunification is poor.
 - e. When the youth's placement is indicating they cannot provide permanency but will provide placement until 18.
 - f. Within 30 days of a removal on a family assigned to in Home.
 - g. Any other case identified with the approval of the assistant manager.
- 10) Integrate Permanency Roundtable process into the Out of Home Policies and Procedures.
- 11) Integrate use of Out of Home data reports in permanency units. The "Open Removals Report" will be used by permanency supervisors to manage cases to achieve timely permanency goals.

Strategy 3: Improve the Timeliness and Appropriateness of Permanency Planning across the Life of the Case

Objective: 3.1.3. (A) Based upon the review of cases, agencies will develop a plan to expedite permanency plans **and** institute process changes to reduce future and ongonig barriers to permanency

Quarter 4 submission noted WCDSS is in a cooperative agreement with the Children's Bureau utilizing two purveyor's, ACTION for Child Protection and the Ruth Young Center, University of Maryland, Baltimore, to address permanency. As part of the agreement, the Children's Cabinet, Inc. worked with WCDSS to review files of children in care over 18 months to determine whether there was an available caregiver work with WCDSS to move the child to permanency. This analysis concluded there were less than 30 children in care longer than 18 months who did not have an available caregiver. Data mining for the project WCDSS found that some systemic issues may keep children in care for longer stays. Safety assessments as they are currently implemented are inadequate and are not used to guide safety decisions. Additionally, there is a lack of in-home safety services that can lead to a higher rate of placement. Further, there is an inadequate assessment of the caregiver protective capacity and the needs of parents and children, as well as inadequate engagement of parents. This inadequate engagement includes infrequent visits between the caseworker and parents and a lack of focused parent-child visits. ¹

Families that are randomized into the treatment group will receive SAFE-FC intervention. Key components of the intervention include protective capacity family assessment and SMART case planning. Additionally, the model design includes case coordination between SAFE-FC caseworkers and a private non-profit community—based agency, The Children's Cabinet, Inc. (Cabinet). The Cabinet will be the service-provider for in-home services to build caregiver protective capacities. Intervention or treatment families will complete computer aided measures to assess resilience, parenting attitudes, social support, parenting stress, parent mental health, home stability, child behavior/mental health, readiness for change, and helping alliance. The WCDSS assigned worker will facilitate a Protective Capacity Functional Assessment and the results will drive the Case Plan and Service Agreement which will be measured through the Protective Capacity Progress Assessment.

While the combined SAFE-FC model has not been tested, there is promising research regarding both SAFE and Family Connections (FC). The anticipated outcomes of the intervention is to 1) reduce the number of children who enter care, 2) reduce the length of to time children remain in care, and 3) reduce the number of children in long-term foster care.

Due to the research requirement of the project, WCDSS must ensure the Control group receives usual permanency services and does not mingle project initiatives with control families. However, to ensure that WCDSS continues to make progress in service delivery, WCDSS is working in collaboration with DCFS and Casey Family Programs to implement Permanency Roundtables. Permanency Roundtables have demonstrated promising results nationally in moving children more quickly to permanency. The Permanency Roundtable Planning Sheet is attached (Attachment 5) and identifies the following implementation activities:

- 1) Orientation and Permanency Values Training in Washoe County June 11, 2012
- 2) Permanency Roundtable SKILLS training July 9, 2012
- 3) Permanency Roundtable in Washoe County, Round 1 July 16-20, 2012

The District Attorney's Office is collaborating with WCDSS to improve timeliness in Termination of Parental Rights hearings and developed a tracking sheet (Attachment 6) to identify barriers to timely filings. The spreadsheet is sent to WCDSS supervisors monthly and is incorporated into monthly management staffing. The worksheet identifies the child, assigned professionals (District Attorney, Case Worker, Parent's Attorney), date TPR was ordered, when the petition should be and is filed, settlement and hearing conference information, and service status. The spreadsheet has proven extremely helpful in tracking barriers and identifying when a task is not being completed.

Also, a policy expert and/or a legal expert should be available to the permanency roundtable team, readily available or on-site.

Many others, including the former CPS caseworker, case-related provider, second-line supervisor, agency administrators, cultural consultants, alumni of foster care, scribe, and veteran parents can be welcomed to the permanency roundtable as participants and observers. Jurisdictions should determine who should be included based on the needs of the jurisdiction and the case. Some jurisdictions have provided honoraria to alumni of foster care, veteran parents, and community partners for their participation and contribution to permanency roundtables.

ORIENTATION AND TRAINING

Orientation and training for the permanency roundtables consists of three elements:

- Orientation: a half-day for all stakeholders that includes a "blessing" by agency leadership;
 a high-level description of the permanency roundtable purpose, process, and players; and
 a permanency roundtable demonstration. The orientation should occur approximately one
 month before the permanency roundtables begin. Some jurisdictions have conducted two
 orientations: one for public agency staff and administrators and another for external partners and
 stakeholders, while other jurisdictions have held one orientation that includes both public agency
 staff and external participants.
- Permanency values training: a full-day training for the caseworkers, supervisors, and
 administrators involved in the permanency roundtables as well as master practitioners and other
 stakeholders, as appropriate. The permanency values training can occur at any time before the
 roundtables. Other staff, administrators, and stakeholders may be invited to the permanency
 values training as determined appropriate by the jurisdiction.
- Permanency roundtable skills training: a full-day training for the permanency consultants, master practitioners, and neutral facilitators (as well as cultural guides, scribes, or any other members of the roundtable team) who will conduct the permanency roundtables. The day focuses on hands-on building of skills related to consultation, facilitation, and giving feedback in the context of the six phases of the permanency roundtable process. The permanency roundtable skills training should occur as close to the start of the permanency roundtables as possible, preferably the day before.

PIP item 3.1.3 (A)

Washoe and the DCFS rural counties are addressing this item through a collaboration with Casey Family Programs. After review of the cases in item 3.1.3, it was noted that there were distinct issues and differences that were creating barriers to permanency in the cases. The Casey Family Programs Permanency Roundtable Process is a process that addresses the issues of barriers to permanency in an individual manner, which appears to be what is needed to move more cases to permanency in a timely manner.

The DCFS rural region and Washoe County have been meeting with Casey Family Programs staff on a regular monthly basis to plan for the training and implementation of the roundtable process. Through these meetings, multiple steps have occurred that to prepare the child welfare agencies for the roundtable process:

- A further identification of cases needing review and a further analysis of the permanency status of each individual case is occurring. A review and analysis of each case is being completed using a form that identifies permanency status as based on the child's safety and stability plan. This review is scheduled to be completed by April 6th, and will prioritize the cases to undergo the PRT process
- Trainings on the first part of the process, the Permanency Values Training will be held June 11th and 12th in Washoe county and Carson City, respectively.
- The second part of the training, the Permanency Roundtable Skills Training, which will be during the same week as the roundtables themselves, is tentatively scheduled for the week of July 16th.
- The PRTs will also occur the week of July 16th.

The Planning sheets, as prepared by Casey Family Programs, are being submitted to document the meetings and status of the roundtables.
