The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations of the Nevada Revised Statutes:

- **NRS 62B:** Relating to juveniles; requiring any person who during the scope of his or her employment has regular and routine contact with juveniles who are involved in the juvenile justice system in this State to complete periodic training relating to implicit bias and cultural competency; requiring the Division of Child and Family Services of the Department of Health and Human Services to adopt regulations concerning such training, as stated in Senate Bill (SB) 108 enacted in 2021.

- **NRS 62H:** Requiring the submittal of certain data and information relating to the competency of children, as stated in Senate Bill (SB) 366 enacted in 2021.

This will be a **virtual only** meeting as authorized pursuant to AB253 (2021). Members of the public may hear and observe the meeting and participate by video or phone. Members of the public may also provide live public comment during the public comments sections of the agenda.
