WORKGROUP ON INFRASTRUCTURE AND COORDINATION**

Meeting Minutes

April 13, 2022

- IV. Review and Approval of Outstanding Workgroup Meeting Minutes from 3/18/22.** Motion by Jackie Harris to approve the March 18th minutes, 2nd by Amanda Haboush-Deloye. The Consortium voted unanimously to approve the 3/18/2022 meeting minutes as presented.
- V. Discussion and Approval of Recommendations regarding Youth Served by Certified Community Behavioral Health Centers (CCBHC's).** Lori Follett reported she has been working on the workgroups dashboards and has a mocked-up draft. Lori will be meeting with her staff for any other input. Lori Follett reported she will have more information at the June meeting. Lori Follett put the DPBH CCBHS's link in the meeting chat box. Jackie suggested more marketing and outreach about the CCBHC's. Lori Follett will take the suggestion back to DPBH.
