
## NEVADA SYSTEM OF CARE PROJECTS — FLEXIBLE FUNDS & RESPITE SERVICES










THE PURPOSE OF SYSTEM OF CARE FLEXIBLE FUNDS IS TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF GOODS AND SERVICES TO SUPPORT THE NEEDS OF YOUTH AND FAMILIES IN THE **SOCIAL AND EDUCATIONAL** DOMAINS. FLEXIBLE FUNDS CAN BE UTILIZED TO SUPPORT THE INDIVIDUALIZED AND UNIQUE NEEDS OF YOUTH SEEKING TO MEET THEIR GOALS AND INCREASE THE ABILITY TO ENGAGE WITH THE NETWORK OF LOCAL COMMUNITY SUPPORTS IN THE SOCIAL AND EDUCATIONAL DOMAINS. FLEXIBLE FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE FOR THE ONE-TIME PURCHASE OF GOODS AND SERVICES THAT INCREASES THEIR ABILITY TO CONNECT AND ENGAGE WITH THESE COMMUNITY SUPPORTS.

Some of the allowable Flexible Funds goods and services may be camp, after school recreational activities, participation on sports teams, services and goods related to hobbies, educational expenses, musical instruments and school supplies. A few of the specific items we've been able to fund include volleyball camp, a basketball hoop, karate classes, a mountain bike, dance lessons and an electric drum kit.











## NUMBER OF FLEX FUND REQUESTS APPROVED BY COUNTY





## **RESPITE FUNDS**

System of Care grant has made available respite funds for children, youth, and their families utilizing the self-directed respite care model. This model allows the parent/guardian to identify their own respite provider. Funds are authorized for a 90-day period (\$400 per month)

- DCFS Wraparound in Nevada/HFW & FOCUS
- DCFS Mobile Crisis Response Team Intensive Step-down
- DPBH Rural Mobile Crisis Response Team
- DPBH Rural Clinics (to include psychiatric services)
- Tribal Health Clinics
