

## Residential Institutions for Children in Nevada

Children in Nevada may reside away from their families in a variety of residential institutions including emergency shelters, childcare institutions, foster homes, psychiatric hospitals, substance abuse treatment facilities, intermediate care facilities, boarding schools, etc. These entities may or may not be licensed by a government agency. They may also be SAPTA-certified to provide substance abuse treatment services.

A license and a certification are different credentials. Licensure addresses the entire scope of the care provided while certification primarily addresses one aspect of the care provided. Licensure indicates that the facility meets minimum regulatory standards for the population it is licensed to serve whereas certification indicates that one aspect of the program meets standards. A license indicates that a wide array of program services has been examined (daily menu, sleeping accommodations, staff-to-child ratio, appropriateness of program, etc.) Certification attests to the adequacy of one program area, such as the substance abuse treatment program. While licensing and certification may overlap certain aspects of the program, licensing is the more comprehensive credential.

**Licensing categories and the agencies that license them include the following:**

- Alcohol and Drug Treatment Facilities—Licensed by HCQC. Programs may be certified by the Nevada State Health Division Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Agency (SAPTA).
- Child Care Institutions—Licensed by HCQC (Child Care Licensing)
- Foster Homes—Licensed by local public agency which provides child welfare services, specifically.
  - Clark County, including cities –CCDFS
  - DCFS Rural Region
  - Washoe County, including cities—WCHSA
- Intermediate Care Facilities—Licensed by HCQC
- Psychiatric Hospitals—Licensed by HCQC
- Other hospitals and skilled nursing facilities—Licensed by HCQC

Juvenile justice facilities generally are not licensed but are overseen by the local court or in the case of the youth training centers, by the State. In Clark County, County-operated juvenile detention facilities are overseen by the Board of Clark County Commissioners.

Below are the names of residential institutions located in the State (on non-tribal lands) that are *most* likely to house children. Also listed are the facility location, primary purpose of the facility and operator.
