Activities Funded and Evaluation Work

Describe the activity funded: Attendance at the 37th Annual San Diego International Conference on Child and Family Maltreatment

The Nye County Children's Advocacy Center's (NCCAC) Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) attended the 37th Annual San Diego International Conference on Child and Family Maltreatment. Attendance at the conference were NCCAC's Child and Family Advocate, a forensic interviewer, three individuals from the Nye County District Attorney's Office (two investigators and a paralegal), three individuals from the Nye County Sheriff's office (two detectives from Pahrump and one detective from Tonopah), the detective from the Esmeralda Sheriff's Office and a Clinical Director from Red Rock Psychological Health. These individuals were able to customize their training by attending educational tracks in their specific areas of expertise (the agenda is being sent for anyone wanting to review). All attendee's expressed their thankfulness for the ability to attend the conference.

This conference also allowed many of our participants to gain accreditation for their specific licenses. The NCCAC is presently applying to the National Children's alliance for their accreditation as well. This training was very beneficial to that requirement as well.

There is a balance on the grant funded of \$2,497.10; Nevada Outreach respectfully requests to utilize the balance of the funds to pay for our annual subscription fee for Vidanyx. Vidanyx is proprietary software that allows forensic interviews to be securely stored and allows only the custodian to grant permissions for others, as necessary, to view the recordings.
