- B. Location of child at the time of death or near fatality (city/county): Las Vegas, Clark
- C. A summary of the report of abuse or neglect and a factual description of the contents of the report:

 CCFS received a report that the 14-year-old was involved in a vehicle vs. dirt-bike collision which occurred at the intersection of two main roads. The child was transported from the scene of the accident to a local area hospital where he was medically assessed as being in critical condition due to multiple injuries.

At the time of the report, there was insufficient information available to establish possible maltreatment. During the course of investigation, there were concerns noted that the child's caregivers failed to exercise reasonable care, supervision, or control in a manner that resulted in physical harm.

The cause of the near fatality was the result of a vehicle vs. dirt-bike collision.

CCFS has the following prior CPS history for this child or member of the child's family or household:

7/11/2021 – A report was received alleging neglect. A referral for a secondary household was created and was coded "Information Only". Upon conclusion of the requisite investigation, the allegations were found unsubstantiated. Based on assessment, the family was referred to a community resource for services. The case closed.

8/25/2022 - A referral was received and was coded "Information Only".

10/25/2022 - A referral was received and was coded "Information Only".

10/27/2022 – A report was received alleging abuse. On 10/28/2022 and 10/29/2022 additional referrals were received and were coded "Information Only". Upon conclusion of the requisite investigation, the allegations were found unsubstantiated. Based on assessment, the family was not in need of services through CCFS. They were provided with information regarding available community resources, and the case closed.

1/6/2023 – A report was received alleging neglect. Upon conclusion of the requisite investigation, the allegations were found substantiated. Based on assessment, the family was provided with appropriate services. They were provided with information regarding available community resources, and the case closed.

2/1/2023 - A referral was received and was coded "Information Only".

8/8/2023 - A referral was received and was coded "Information Only".

10/15/2023 – A referral was received and was coded "Information Only".

1/6/2024 - A referral was received and was coded "Information Only".

4/25/2024 – A referral was received and was coded "Information Only".

1/27/2025 – A referral was received and was coded "Information Only".
