Strategic Plan Goals

- Goal 1. Increase coordination and collaboration in identifying and serving CSEC.
- Goal 2. Expand access to services for CSEC and their families.
- Goal 3. Improve outcomes for CSEC through increased expertise and data-driven services.
- Goal 4. Increase awareness of CSEC in Nevada through public awareness campaigns.
- Goal 5. Sustain the effort to coordinate and improve services for CSEC.

Potential Subcommittee Structures

Sample Structures for the Coalition to consider. They Coalition may choose a subcommittee structure not listed below.

Option A – Function Model

Training & Technical Assistance – review and development of training for local Task Forces, MDTs and Service providers. Linking technical assistance resources to local entities and helping to review policies and procedures.

Outreach and Communication – develop and execute awareness strategies, targeted outreach to key industries, and legislative tracking.

Data and Quality Assurance – establish key data to be collected, communication of data, review practices of local task forces, inform other subcommittees to assist in their duties.

Option B – Target Entity Model

Local Task Force Support – tracks and assist local task forces in their work including policy development, training, technical assistance, and communication.

External Engagement – public awareness, legislative or regulatory affairs, and other engagement with external partners to support the work of the Coalition

Funding & Sustainability – targeted approach to identify revenue streams for services and system supports

Coalition Development and Support – data collection and dissemination, Coalition member development, and review of strategic plan progress.
