

## Proposed Data Points for Children's Commission Behavioral Health Subcommittee

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### Data Points Illustrating the Number of Youth Potentially in Need of Behavioral Health Services

- Number of youth in the Unity System showing a mental health diagnosis
- Number of youth in the Unity System who meet criteria for Serious Emotional Disturbance
- Number of youth in the Unity System taking psychotropic medications
- Behavioral health placements/services currently provided for children in the Unity System
- Number of current youth in Special Needs Adoption status due to behavioral health concerns
- Number of youth with developmental disabilities in the Unity System
- Number of youth entering child welfare custody to obtain behavioral health services
- Number of youth with Emergency Room stays awaiting placement
- Number of youth in out of state placement
- Number of youth covered by Medicaid
- Number of uninsured youth
- Review the state epidemiology data for relevant indicators
- Review juvenile justice data submitted to the State to create a similar data base for justice involved youth (e.g. Residential placement, diagnoses, youth in behavioral health placements etc).
- Use national prevalence to estimate projected number of Nevada's youth in the general population and on Medicaid who are likely to meet the criteria for Serious Emotional Disturbance

### Data Points to Capture Current Available State Run Services

- Break down of beds for all services and current open beds
- Staff vacancy rates across each program
- Waiting list data for each program
- Wrap Around positions open and filled
- Wrap Around caseloads and waiting list
- Mobile Crisis Positions open and filled
- Mobile Crisis caseloads and waiting list
- Outpatient Service positions open and filled
- Outpatient/Early Childhood caseloads and waiting lists
- Medicaid providers at each level of care with capacity and open slots
- Number of instate residential and acute care beds
- Child and adolescent behavioral health provider data from the Boards.

- Barriers to entering services
- Number of youth projected to meet criteria for services currently in system care
