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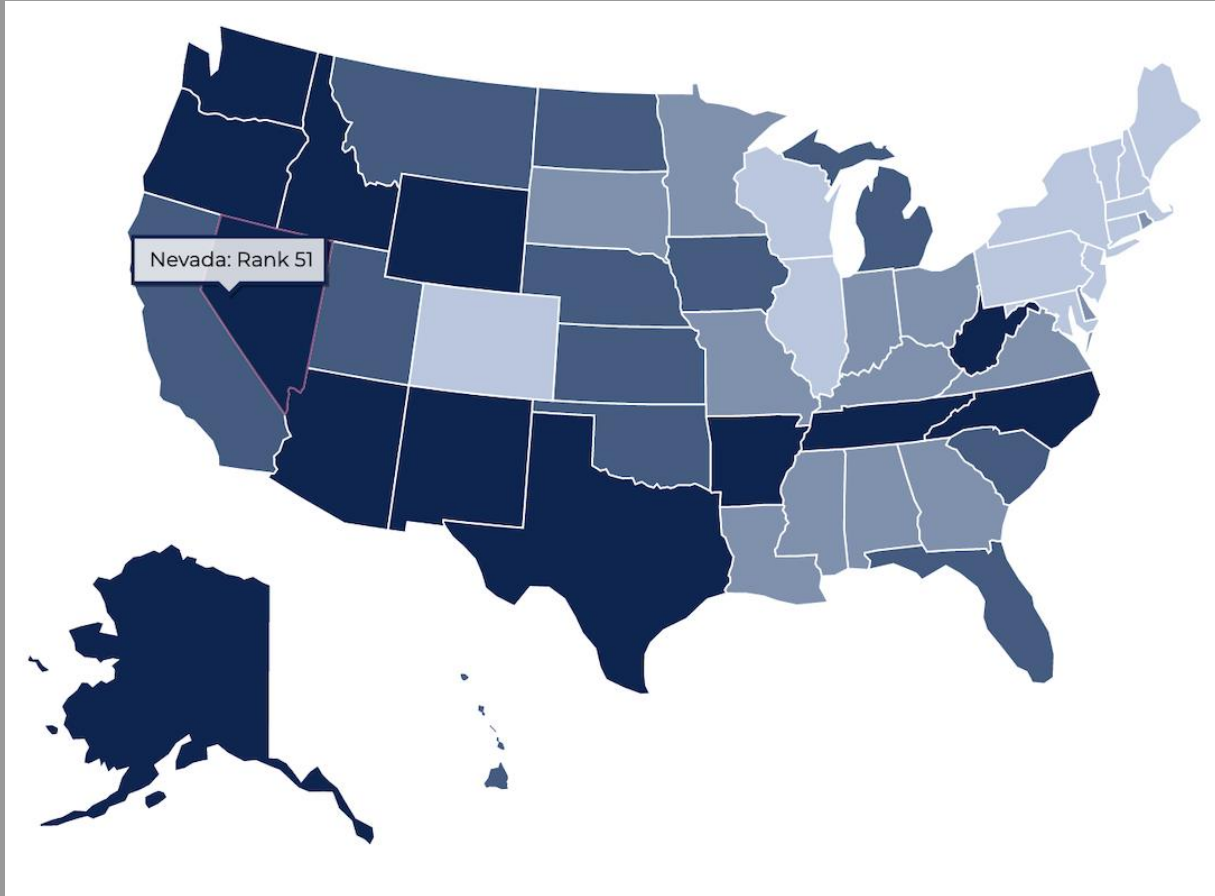

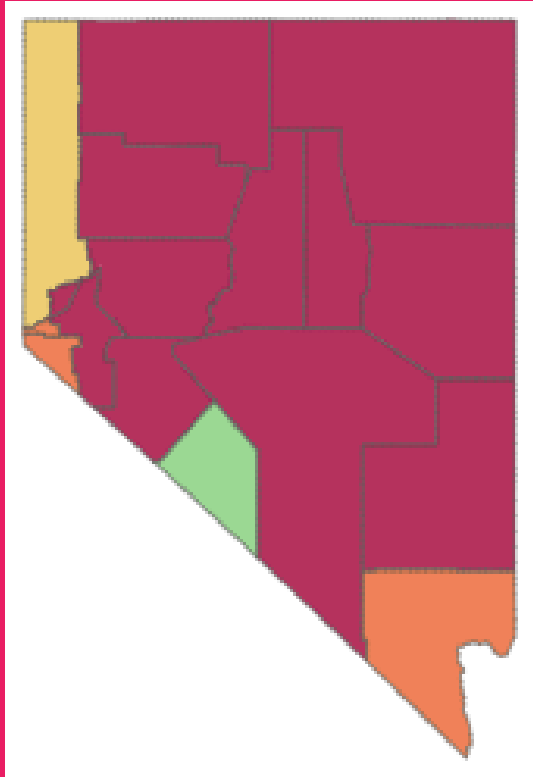
The Problem

- At least ½ youth with MH problem do NOT receive treatment
- Pediatricians report feeling they lack the training to treat MH problems
- There is a national shortage of child mental health providers

1. Youth with at least one MDE in the past year
2. Youth with SUD in the past year
3. Youth with severe MDE
4. Youth with MDE who did NOT receive care
5. Youth with MDE who received some care
6. Youth with private insurance that excludes MH
7. Youth identified as SED

Solutions

- 2004, Massachusetts Child Psychiatry Access Project was implemented
- WA Partnership Access Line came next
- 2011, National Network of Child Psychiatry Access Programs established (www.nncpap.org)
- 46 states now have a CPAP

What IS a CPAP

- Physician to physician dedicated telephonic consultation hotlines
- Immediate/same day telephonic support on diagnosis, management, and care coordination
- Many also provide tele-video consultation

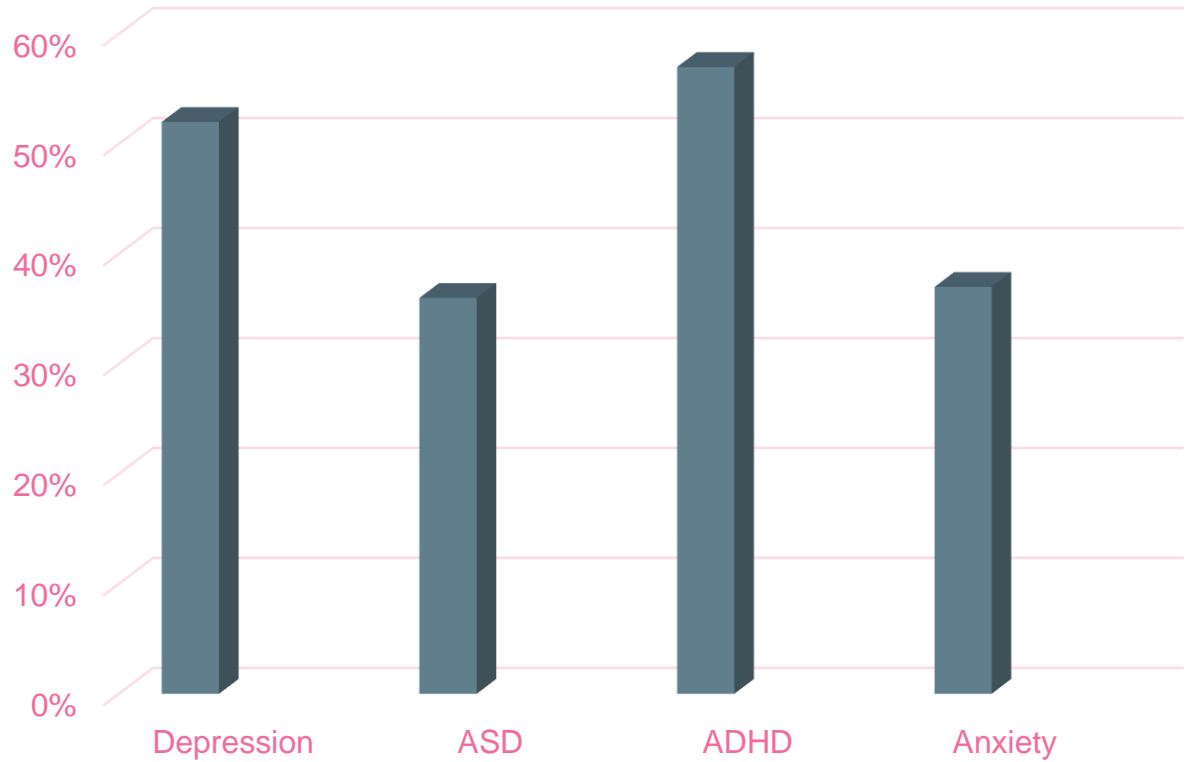

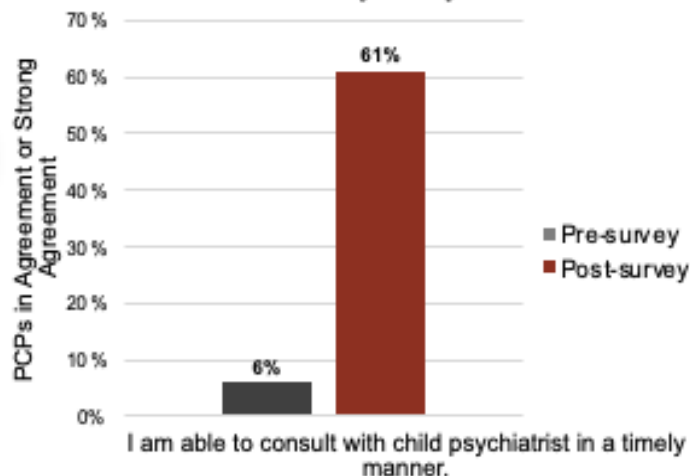

Pre- and Post-Survey Comparison

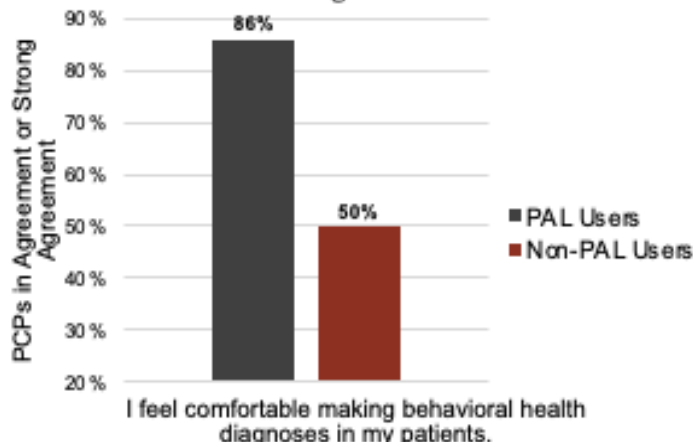
Access to Child Psychiatry Consult

Sustainability

- Program Annual Cost: \$750,000
- Benefits:
 - Immediate mental health support for PCPs statewide
 - Improved comfort of primary care clinicians = less referrals out
 - Improved access to care statewide
- Examples of sustainable funding:
 - Legislative line item
 - Insurance surcharge
 - Medicaid support, including MCOs

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
