### GUIDELINES

The scholarship is open to aged out foster youth. The application is available every year on the DCFS website and applications and all attachments are due April 15<sup>th</sup>. You can reapply for the scholarship for a maximum of 5 years – up to \$40,000!

Potential recipients must:

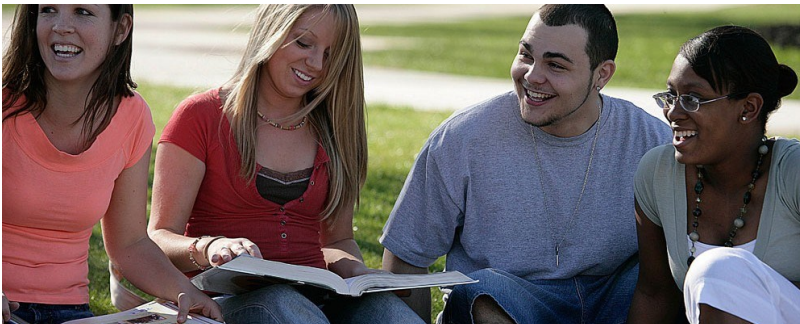
- Apply before their 20<sup>th</sup> birthday
- Attend a school in Nevada
- Begin their post high school education within 12 months of being awarded the scholarship
- Have a 2.0 GPA
- Plan on attending school full time

### WHAT IT PAYS FOR

- Tuition
- On campus room & board
- Books
- Student Health Insurance
- On campus meal plans

### HOW TO APPLY

1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) prior to April 15<sup>th</sup>
2. Print off a copy of the scholarship application & policy from the DCFS website: <http://dcfs.nv.gov/Programs/CWS/IL/OtherEd/>
3. Fill out application & Sign the policy
4. Write 2 essays
5. Get 2 letters of recommendation
6. Send in your application!
