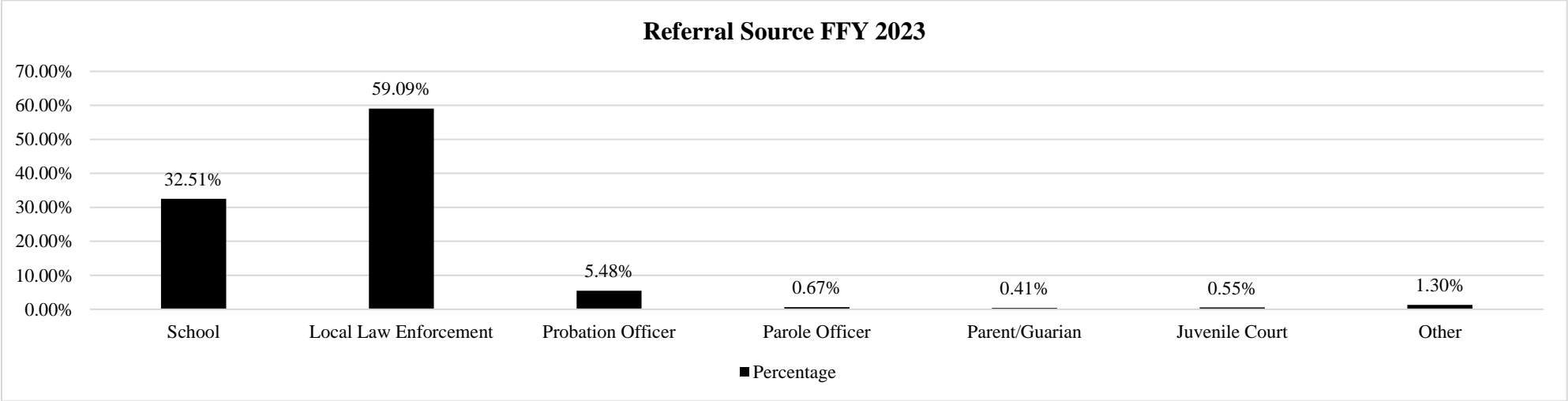

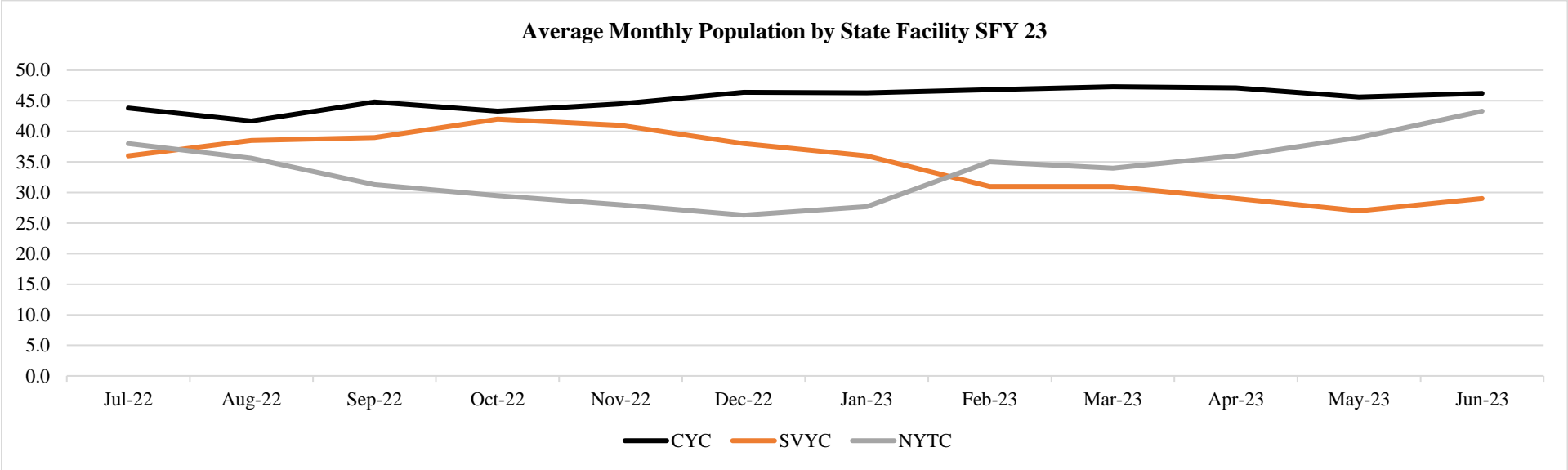

Table 7: Average Length of Stay in State Facilities

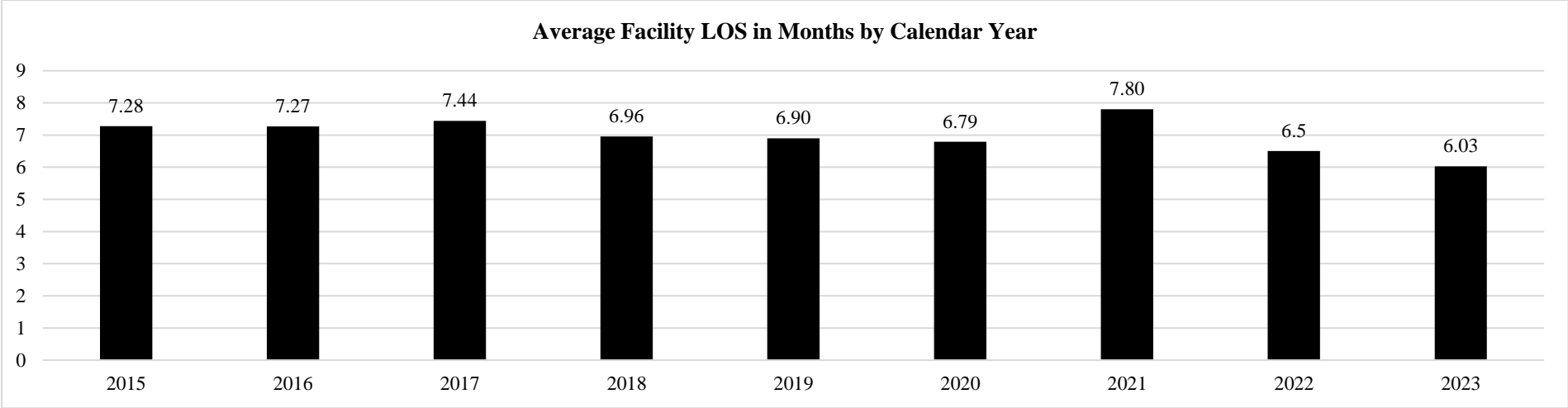

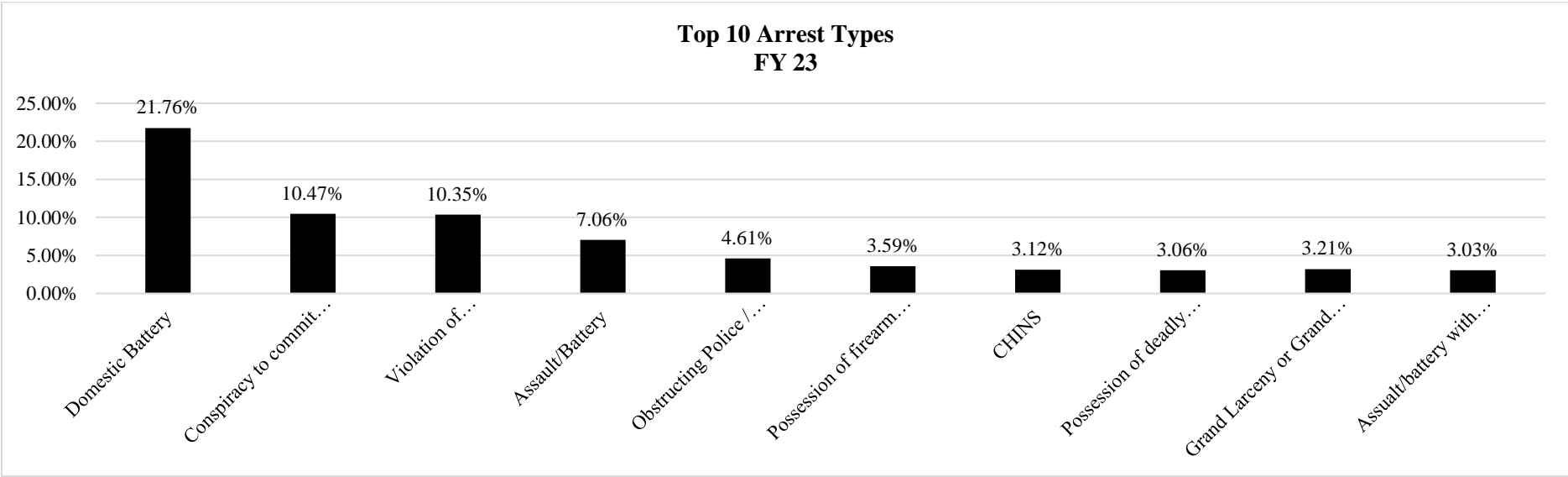


Table 11: Top Ten Juvenile Rearrest Types FY 2023

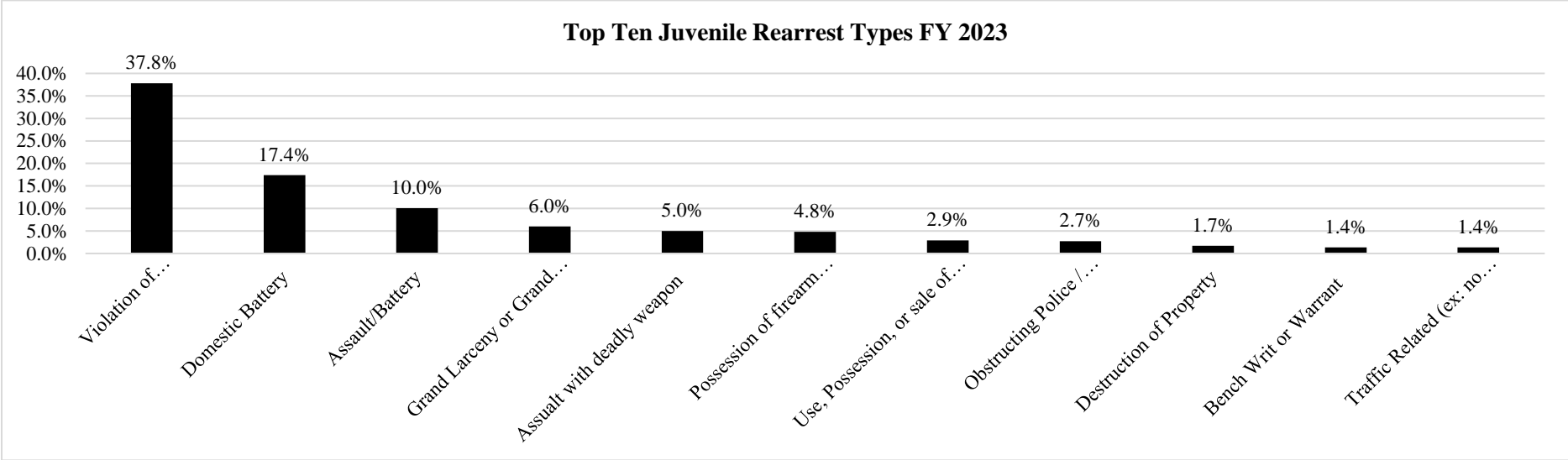
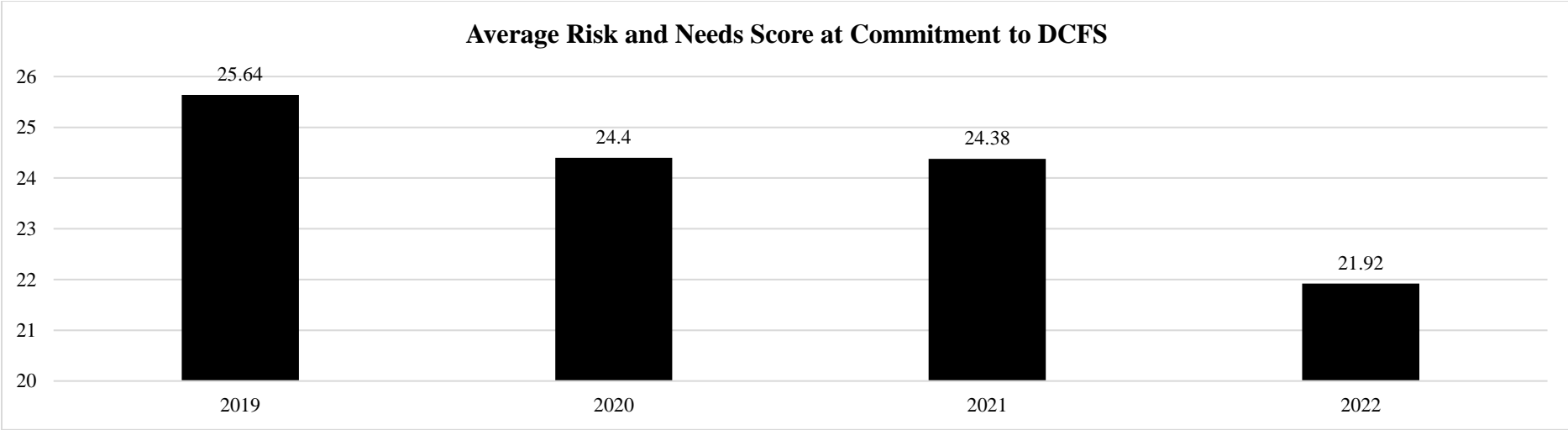


Table 12: Average Risk and Needs Score at Commitment to DCFS



The average risk score for the risk and needs assessments in calendar year 2022 is 21.92 which falls into moderate risk level for both males and females. While there has been a drop in overall score, the egregiousness of the delinquent act has warranted placement in a state facility.
