    - 1. Define “disposition” for measurement (Pg 29): Previous meeting discussion: An action taken. Come up with a sentence to define this so it can be measured.
  - iv. Performance Based Standards (Pg 31): The Correctional Program Checklist (CPC) is used. Propose changing to follow the “domains” of this tool.
