Recommendations for the Commission, for Possible Action:

- 1. <u>Provide a stipend for JJOC Youth members</u>. There has been difficulty recruiting and retaining youth members. A stipend may serve as an incentive and potential reimbursement for expenses associated with travel and time commitments.
- 2. <u>Hire a consultant to organize the FY 2024-2028 Strategic Plan</u>. SB 398 (2017) requires the JJOC Strategic Plan be updated (FY 2024-2028), approved by the JJOC and then submitted to the Legislature. While the Strategic Planning Committee worked with DCFS staff to create a report on the current status of goals established from the FY19-23 Strategic Plan, the development of an updated plan requires professional assistance. The State hired a consulting company to construct the original strategic plan.
