Risk Assessment Committee – On December 15, 2017, the Juvenile Justice Oversight Commission voted unanimously to adopt the YLS as the statewide risk and needs assessment tool and the MAYSI II as the statewide mental health screening tool. In addition, this committee will be tasked with the requirements surrounding quality assurance protocols for the use of these tools statewide.
