

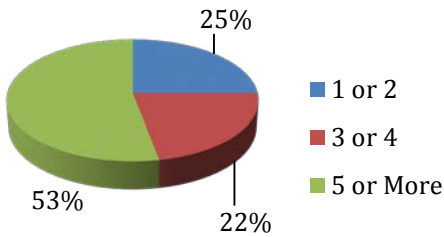

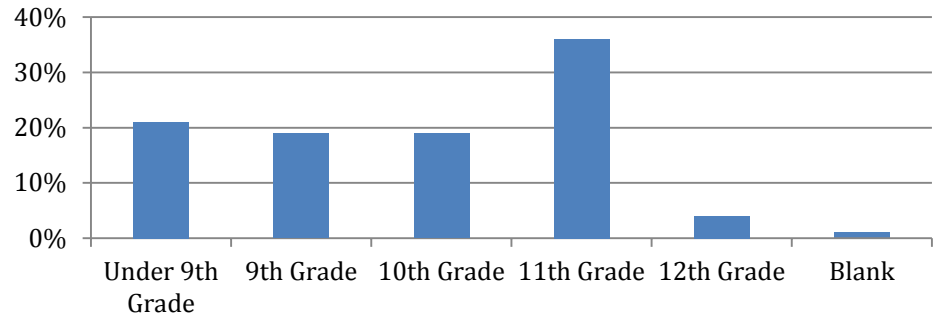

### Number of services received (FY15)

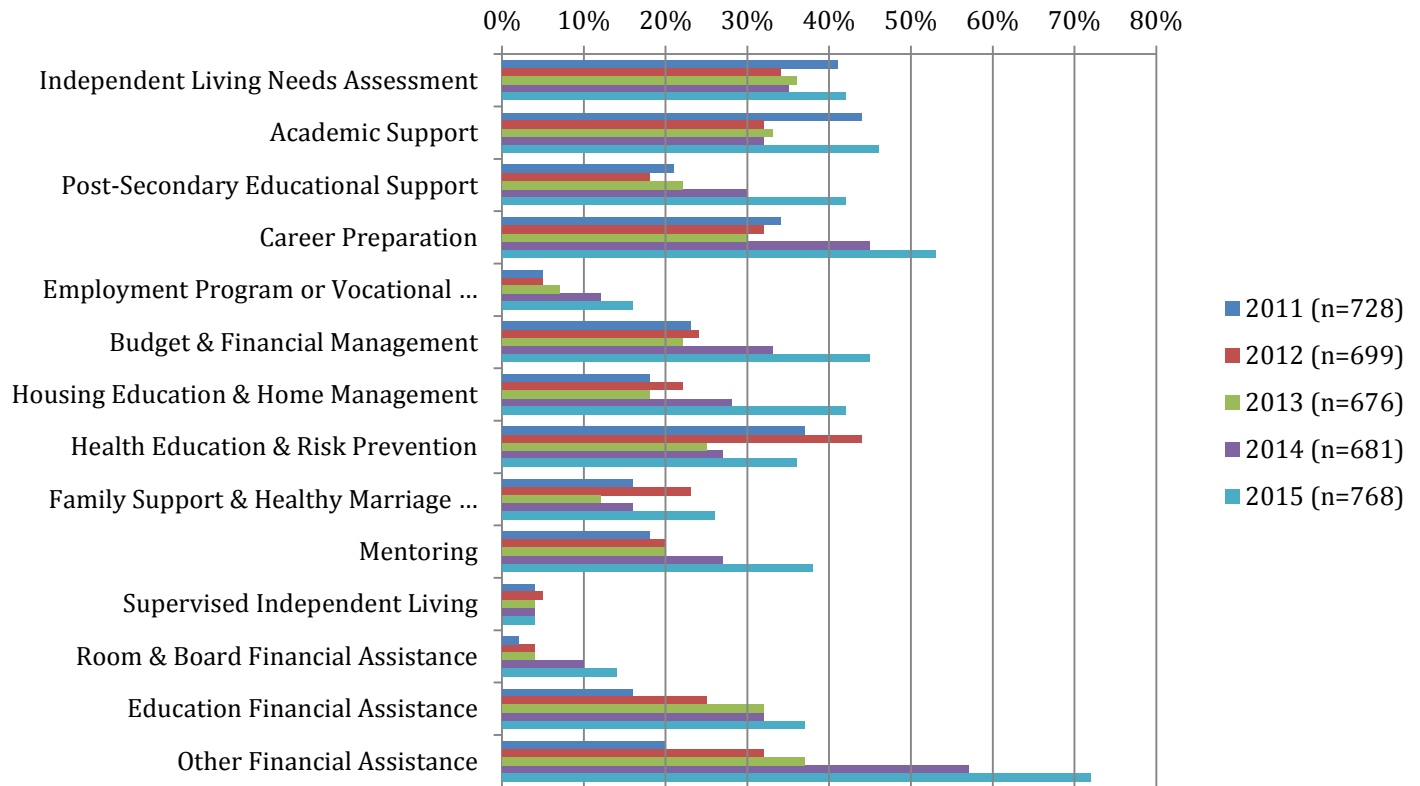


### Education level of youth receiving services (FY 15)



### Type of services received (FY 11-15)




Percent of youth receiving each service (of total youth served)
