VOCA SFY25 FAQs

- (1). Is the budget/performance period 12 months or 13 months?
 - ▶ The grant's performance period is 13 months; from July 1, 2024 July 31, 2025.
- (2). Are volunteers able to be counted for "In-kind" only or are they two separate groups of people?
 - Volunteers' time may be counted towards match as in-kind. However, if volunteers are written into a program as a focus area and to be counted as program participants (i.e., as deliverable numbers), then they cannot be counted twice.
- (3). Will DCFS-GMU be offering VOCA Match Waivers during SFY25?
 - We are no longer offering VOCA Match Waivers across the board. However, agencies can still request a waiver and GMU-VS will review on a case-by-case basis.
- (4). Can the Indirect Cost Rate be used to meet match?
 - VOCA funds may be used to support a Grantee's federally negotiated indirect cost rate or a de minimis indirect rate of 10% of modified total direct costs (MTDC) as defined in 2 C.F.R. §200.414.
- (5). Are subcontractors allowed under VOCA?
 - Yes, subcontractors are allowed to work on VOCA-funded projects. If you will be working with subcontractors, please mark yes on the application where indicated.
